SA STATE BUDGET WOMEN'S STATEMENT

The 2023/24 Malinauskas Labor State Budget includes a Women's Statement as Government and community work together to promote safety, wellbeing and equality for women and girls.

The Statement is part of a whole of government effort to improve the outcomes of women and embed gender equality considerations across all areas of government business.

In South Australia women and girls make up 51 per cent of the population, and 30.8 per cent of women put in more than 14 hours of domestic work every week in addition to a full-time job.

Out of all South Australian incorporated enterprises with employees, **29.2 per cent are owned/managed by women**, and the gender pay gap in the State is **7.4 per cent** (just over half the national average).

South Australian women's participation in the workforce remains lower than men's, particularly in management positions and women continue to retire with less superannuation.

Women make up **58 per cent** of executives in South Australia's State Government, **48.6 per cent** of the Government's Board Members, and **30.2 per cent** of the State's apprentices and trainees.
